This course provides an opportunity to deepen one's knowledge of Israelite prophecy through an in-depth study of the book of Isaiah. The aims of the course are to establish a thorough knowledge of the historical, geographical, and social background of Isaiah and construct a detailed knowledge of the text of Isaiah. To do this the lecturer will facilitate a through-going critique of the contemporary debates concerning the unity and themes of Isaiah to enable students to develop an advanced critical ability to exegete passages from Isaiah and apply an understanding of Isaiah to preaching and worship in faith contexts.

## Content

1. Theories concerning the unity of the book of Isaiah
2. Text, literary forms, and poetry of Isaiah
3. The historical, social, religious, and cultural background of the book.
4. Themes of Isaiah including Immanuel, the Servant, and the Zion tradition
5. Exegesis of selected passages
