UNIT OBJECTIVES

This course unit provides for an understanding of the physical, social, psychological and spiritual dimensions of the human life cycle through all the stages from infancy to older age. As such, it provides knowledge of life experiences that can be addressed in pastoral care and counselling.

P7101 Introduction to Pastoral Theology and Ministry or C7146 Introduction to Pastoral Counselling.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

At the end of this unit students will be able to:

1. Demonstrate a sound knowledge of the stages of the life cycle as described by a number of developmental theorists
2. Identify the developmental nature of faith and moral reasoning
3. Critique contemporary gender issues
4. Address developmental concerns within pastoral care and counselling
5. Demonstrate increased self-awareness of developmental issues within their own lives

CONTENT

1. Life cycle theorists, e.g. Freud, Erikson, Jung, Bronfenbrenner
2. Moral & faith development: Piaget, Kohlberg, Fowler
3. Developmental tasks: e.g. early attachments, identity, sexuality, career, marriage & family, mid-life changes, ageing
4. Issues pertaining to gender studies
5. The life cycle and pastoral counselling
